## 32-2659: PGAM1 Recombinant Protein

**Alternative Name:** Phosphoglycerate mutase isozyme B,PGAM-B,PGAMA.

## **Description**

Source: Escherichia Coli. PGAM1 Human Recombinant produced in E.Coli is a single, non-glycosylated, polypeptide chain containing 274 amino acids (1-254 a.a.) and having a molecular mass of 30.9 kDa. The PGAM1 is fused to a 20 amino acid His Tag at N-Terminus and purified by proprietary chromatographic techniques. PGAM1 is part of the phosphoglycerate mutase family. PGAM1 is an essential component of glucose and 2,3-BPGA (2,3-bisphosphoglycerate) metabolism and catalyzes the reversible reaction of 3-phosphoglycerate (3-PGA) to 2-phosphoglycerate (2-PGA) in the glycolytic pathway. PGAM1 is a dimeric enzyme containing, in different tissues, different proportions of a slow-migrating muscle (MM) isozyme, a fast-migrating brain (BB) isozyme, and a hybrid form (MB). PGAM1 mutations lead to muscle phosphoglycerate mutase deficiency, a.k.a. glycogen storage disease X.

**Amount :** 25 μg

**Purification:** Greater than 90% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Content: The PGAM1 1mg/ml protein solution contains 20mM Tris-HCl pH-8, 1mM DTT, and 10% glycerol.
