

32-3400: mCALB2 Recombinant Protein

Alternative Name : Calretinin,CR,Calb2,calbindin 2.

Description

Source : Escherichia Coli. Calretinin Mouse Recombinant full length protein expressed in E.coli, shows a 57 kDa band on SDS-PAGE. The Calretinin is purified by proprietary chromatographic techniques. Calretinin is an intracellular calcium-binding protein belonging to the troponin C superfamily characterized by a structural motif described as the EF-hand domain. The immunohistochemical detection of calretinin in developing cerebellum is restricted to the later stages indicated by weak staining from week 21 of gestation, in Purkinje and basket cells and in neurons of the dentate nucleus. The intensity of staining increases as the cerebellum matures. In tumors, calretinin has been detected in mesotheliomas and some pulmonary adenocarcinomas.

Content : Calretinin protein at 100 μ g/ml in 50mM Tris-HCl, pH7.5 and 10mM L-glutathione (reduced).
Storage condition : Store vial at -20°C to -80°C. When stored at the recommended temperature, this protein is stable for 12 months. Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.
