<b>Amount :</b>	50 $\mu$ l / 100 $\mu$ l
<b>Content :</b>	Supplied at 1.0mg/mL in phosphate buffered saline (without Mg <sup>2+</sup> and Ca <sup>2+</sup> ), pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.
<b>Storage condition :</b>	Store the antibody at 4°C, stable for 6 months. For long-term storage, store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze and thaw cycles.

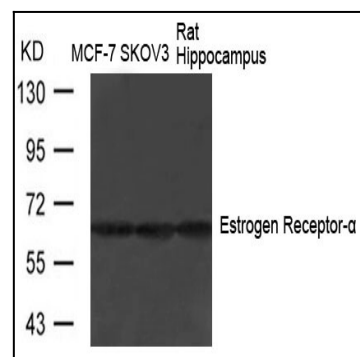


Figure 1: Western blot analysis of extracts from MCF-7, SKOV3 and Rat Hippocampus using Estrogen Receptor- Alpha

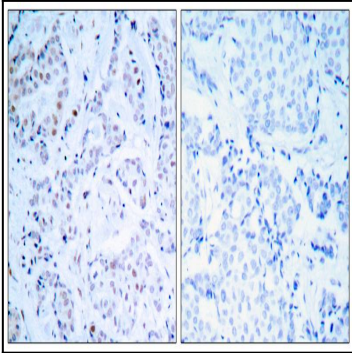


Figure 2: Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded human breast carcinoma tissue using Estrogen Receptor-a(Ab-104) Antibody 35-1419 (left) or the same antibody preincubated with blocking peptide(right).
