Â In interferon-gamma-activated macrophages, MIF stimulates nitric oxide (NO) production and tumor necrosis factor alpha (TNF-alpha) secretion.Â



Application Note

Endotoxin: Less than 0.1 ng/ $\tilde{A} \square \hat{A} \mu g$ (1 IEU/ $\tilde{A} \square \hat{A} \mu g$) as determined by LAL test.

Centrifuge vial before opening, Suspend the product by gently pipetting the above recommended solution down the sides of the vial. DO NOT VORTEX. Allow several minutes for complete reconstitution.
