Â PDGF functions as a mitogenic growth hormone on cells of mesenchymal lineage, such as smooth muscle and glial cells. Â PDGF is also stored in the alpha-granules of platelets and is released upon adherence to traumatized tissues. Â PDGF is a dimeric glycoprotein formed by two A chains (AA), two B chains (BB), or as a heterodimer with an A and a B chain (AB). Â The PDGF dimer binds the cell surface receptor tyrosine kinases PDGFR-alpha and PDGFR-beta .Â



Application Note

Endotoxin: Less than 0.1 ng/ $\tilde{A} \square \hat{A} \mu g$ (1 IEU/ $\tilde{A} \square \hat{A} \mu g$) as determined by LAL test.

Biological Activity was determined by 3T3 cell proliferation at <=50 ng/mL; $>=2.0 \times 10^4$ units/mg (typical ED50 is <25 ng/mL). Centrifuge vial before opening, Suspend the product by gently pipetting the above recommended solution down the sides of the vial. DO NOT VORTEX. Allow several minutes for complete reconstitution. For prolonged storage, dilute to working aliquots in a 0.1% BSA solution, store at $-80\tilde{A}$ \square Å $^\circ$ C and avoid repeat freeze thaws. Upon reconstitution, a small amount of visible precipitate can be expected. A 10% overfill has been added to the total material vialed to compensate for this loss.





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
