Description

It recognizes a protein of 70kDa, identified as prolactin receptor. Prolactin is a pituitary hormone involved in the stimulation of milk production, salt and water regulation, growth, development and reproduction. The initial step in its action is the binding to a specific membrane receptor (prolactin receptor), which belongs to the superfamily of class 1 cytokine receptors. The function of the prolactin receptor is mediated, at least in part, by two families of signaling molecules: Janus kinases and signal transducers and activators of transcription.

Content: 200 µg/ml of Ab Purified from Bioreactor Concentrate by Protein A/G. Prepared in 10mM PBS

with 0.05% BSA & 0.05% azide. Also available WITHOUT BSA at 1.0mg/ml.

Storage condition : Antibody with azide - store at 2 to 8°C. Antibody is stable for 24 months. Non-hazardous.

Application Note

Immunohistochemistry (Formalin-fixed) (1-2ug/ml for 30 minutes at RT),(Staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires heating tissue sections in 10mM Tris with 1mM EDTA, pH 9.0, for 45 min at 95°C followed by cooling at RT for 20 minutes);




Fig. 1: SDS-PAGE Analysis Purified Prolactin Receptor Recombinant Rabbit Monoclonal (PRLR3785R). Confirmation of Integrity and Purity of Antibody.




Fig. 2: Formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded human testicular carcinoma stained with Prolactin Receptor Recombinant Rabbit Monoclonal (PRLR3785R).
