

## 32-17110: Recombinant human TIGIT Protein with C-His tag

**Alternative Name :** TIGIT, VSIG9, VSTM3

### Description

Expression Host : HEK293

The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 13.85 kDa after removal of the signal peptide. The apparent molecular mass of TIGIT-His is approximately 17-25 kDa due to glycosylation.

This gene encodes a member of the PVR (poliovirus receptor) family of immunoglobulin proteins. The product of this gene is expressed on several classes of T cells including follicular B helper T cells (TFH). The protein has been shown to bind PVR with high affinity; this binding is thought to assist interactions between TFH and dendritic cells to regulate T cell dependent B cell responses.

### Product Info

<b>Amount :</b>	50 µg
<b>Purification :</b>	The purity of the protein is greater than 95% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining.
<b>Content :</b>	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization.
<b>Storage condition :</b>	Store at -80°C for 12 months (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing)

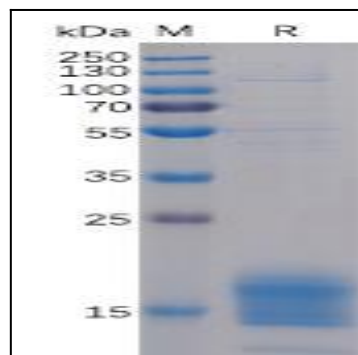


Figure 1. Human TIGIT Protein, His Tag on SDS-PAGE under reducing condition.

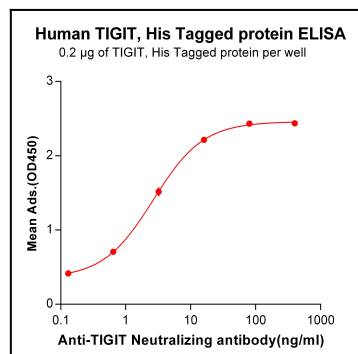


Figure 2. ELISA plate pre-coated by 2 µg/ml (100 µl/well) Human TIGIT, His tagged protein can bind Anti-TIGIT Neutralizing antibody in a linear range of 0.13-16.0 ng/ml.
