Description

Molecular Characterization: PGLYRP1(Gln22-Pro196) 6 \AA —His tag

Molecular weight: The protein has a predicted molecular mass of 20.3 kDa after removal of the signal peptide. The apparent molecular mass of PGLYRP1-His is approximately 15-25 kDa due to glycosylation.

Description: Recombinant human PGLYRP1 protein with C-terminal 6 \AA —His tag

Pattern receptor that binds to murein peptidoglycans (PGN) of Gram-positive bacteria. Has bactericidal activity towards Gram-positive bacteria. May kill Gram-positive bacteria by interfering with peptidoglycan biosynthesis. Binds also to Gram-negative bacteria, and has bacteriostatic activity towards Gram-negative bacteria. Plays a role in innate immunity.[UniProtKB/Swiss-Prot Function]

Product Info

Amount : 100 μg / 50 μg

Content : Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8% trehalose is added as protectants before lyophilization.

Storage condition : Store at -20 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ to -80 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ for 12 months in lyophilized form. After reconstitution, if not intended for use within a month, aliquot and store at -80 $^{\circ}\text{C}$ (Avoid repeated freezing and thawing). Lyophilized proteins are shipped at ambient temperature.
