Application Note

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized Leptin Antagonist Quadruple Mutant in sterile 0.4% NaHCO3adjusted to pH 8-9, not less than 100µg/ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions. The Leptin Quadruple Antagonist Mutant is capable of inhibiting leptin-induced proliferation of BAF/3 cells stably transected with the long form of human Leptin receptor. It also inhibits various Leptin effects in several in vitro bioassays.
