

Flow Cytometry (0.5-1ug/million cells); Immunofluorescence (0.5-1ug/ml); Immunohistology (Formalin-fixed) (0.5-1ug/ml for 30 minutes at RT) [For staining of formalin-fixed tissues, incubate sections in 4N HCl for 30 minutes at RT followed by digestion with trypsin at 1mg/ml PBS, 10 min at 37oC]
